### **Position Summary:**

The Sanitation Supervisor will be responsible to supervisor and coordinate the activities of team members engaged in sanitation programs per GFSI guidelines in a food processing establishment.

### **Essential Duties:**

- Inspects equipment for conformity to federal and state sanitation laws and plant standards.
- Directs cleaning of equipment and work areas.
- Inspects premises for unsanitary practices and conditions.
- Confers with Team Leaders and Team Members on sanitation problems, and recommends changes in equipment, plant layout, lighting, ventilation, or work practices to improve sanitation standards.
- Ensures adherence to procedures, including CGMP, BRC, and validates all required reports regarding regular inspections, sanitation violations, and root cause analysis outlining steps required to resolve deficiencies.
- Interprets company policies to team members and enforces safety regulations.
- Establishes or adjust work procedures to meet production schedules and validate job standards needed to perform those tasks.
- Confers with supervisors to coordinate activities of individual department cleaning needs.
- Develop and maintain sanitation and cleaning requirements by entering schedules within Tabware (sanitation software)
- Supports the Sconza Values.
- Food safety is the responsibility of each employee, and they must demonstrate this every day during their role in the manufacture and distribution of safe, wholesome, and high-quality products.
- Understands and complies with all HACCP and CGMP requirements and processes
- Understands and complies with RSPO and organic programs
- Write, update, and maintain Sanitation SOP
- Participation in pre-operative inspections with Line Leads
- Perform other duties as assigned
